

Guidance on Appointing Piedmont Friends Yearly Meeting Representatives

At its meeting on July 20, 2014 the Yearly Meeting Formation Committee prepared the following points of guidance relative to PFYM representatives understanding that the PFYM representative body will discern these responsibilities in more detail. This guidance may be helpful to meetings in naming representatives to PFYM

- Ability to serve for a three-year term. It may be decided that terms should be staggered.
- Availability to meet every two months from September 2014 through March 2015
- Readiness to discern the work of building the framework of the new yearly meeting, as this will likely be the primary early work of this representative body
- Readiness for carrying the responsibility for acting as a communication channel in both directions between the yearly meeting and the monthly meeting, e.g., reporting regularly to the monthly meeting on yearly meeting progress and conveying monthly meeting/worship group concerns at representative body meetings.

Note: Representatives to PFYM and PFF can be separate appointments, the same or a combination depending on the individual's availability to serve.
